## DAY 1



### *Mount Congreve Gardens*

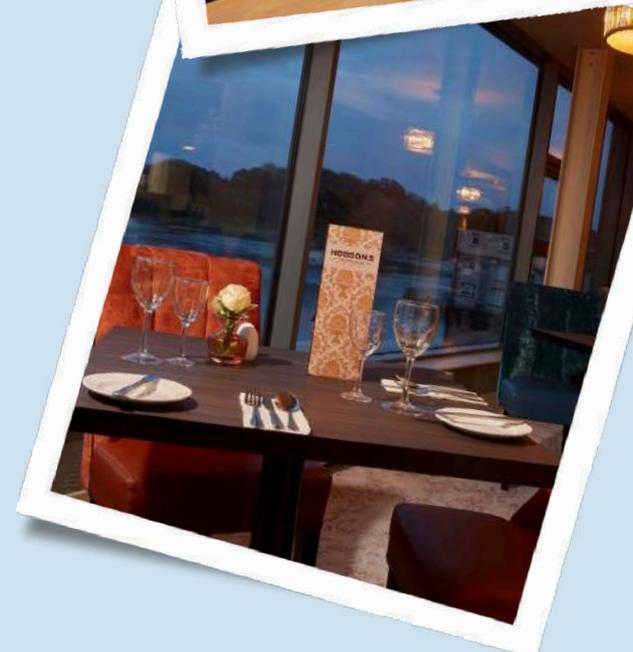
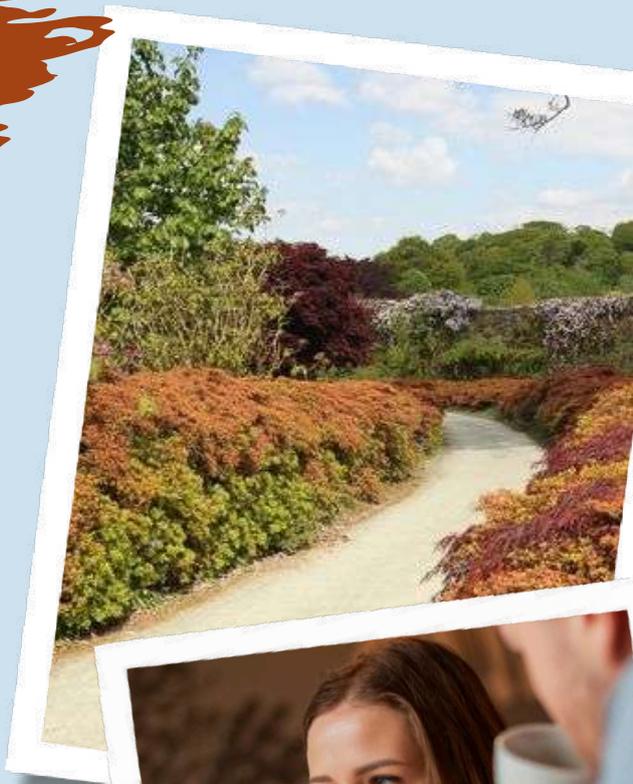
### *City Centre*
