DAY 1



The Viking Triangle

Start your Waterford adventure by exploring the historic Viking Triangle, located just steps from The Tower Hotel.

Begin at Reginald's Tower, just a 1 minute walk from the hotel, where you can learn about the city's Viking origins and enjoy stunning views over the River Suir.

Continue your journey through history with a visit to the Waterford Medieval Museum, home to remarkable artefacts and fascinating stories from the city's medieval past.

A short stroll away you'll find the House of Waterford Crystal, where visitors can take a guided tour and watch skilled craftsmen create the world-famous crystal pieces.




Local Cafes & Boutiques

In the afternoon, wander through the charming streets of the Viking Triangle, explore local boutiques and enjoy lunch or coffee in one of the nearby cafés.



Dinner at Hobsons

Finish your day with dinner at The Tower Hotel while enjoying views of the marina and Reginald's Tower as the city comes alive in the evening.



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DAY 2



Waterford Greenway

Day two is perfect for exploring the great outdoors with a trip along the Waterford Greenway, one of Ireland's most popular walking and cycling routes.

Bike hire is available in the city centre, and the Greenway access point is approximately 5–10 minutes from The Tower Hotel.

Along the route you'll pass through:

- The scenic Durrrow Tunnel
- The impressive Ballyvoyle Viaduct
- Picturesque villages and countryside
- Stunning views along the Copper Coast

Many visitors choose to cycle part of the route and stop for lunch in the seaside town of Dungarvan before returning to Waterford.

DAY 3



Beaches & Coastal Villages

On your final day, take time to explore the beautiful coastline surrounding Waterford.

Just 15 minutes from The Tower Hotel, Tramore Beach offers a long sandy shoreline perfect for swimming, walking or enjoying an ice cream along the promenade.

For a charming coastal escape, visit Dunmore East, approximately 20 minutes from the hotel. This picturesque fishing village features a lovely harbour, cliff walks and excellent seafood restaurants.

If you prefer a quieter beach experience, Annestown Beach along the Copper Coast provides dramatic scenery and peaceful surroundings.



City Centre Shopping

Before departing, return to Waterford city centre to enjoy some last-minute shopping, explore the museums or relax with a bite to eat in one of the many cafés.
